

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Social Sciences – Teacher Education

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Joliet Junior College (JJC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Social Sciences – Teacher Education degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from JJC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Social Sciences with Teacher Education from GSU. **The BA in Social Sciences – Teacher Education program has special admissions requirements; please refer to the GSU catalog.**
