

Associate of Applied Science for PSC Occupational Programs to Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Prairie State College (PSC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Interdisciplinary Studies degree program based on the catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree from PSC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Interdisciplinary Studies from GSU.
