Every Discussion community looks different. o Chestnut is one of 5 leadership centers in the state. IDHS SUPR's vision: "A continuum of services available to all Illinoisans." Health outcomes rating for Montgomery county is 75th out of 102 Illinois counties. o Ratio of population to primary care physicians 2040:1 Mont. C. vs 1240:1 IL. Ratio of population to mental health providers 1350:1 Mont. C. vs 410:1 IL. O Youth survey data - 8th grade: Alcohol – 16%, e-cigarettes or vaping 13%, marijuana 5%, prescription drugs 2%.

month alone.

- 40% of students felt hopeless and stopped doing daily tasks.
- Need schools to participate in these surveys more.
- O Adult data:
 - 2021 12 overdose deaths (all involve Fentanyl).
 - 2020 Opioid death rate per 100,000 = 31.5. IL overdose rate is 23.
- O Gaps across the continuum of care:
 - Health promotion increase of stigma because lack of understanding about substance use and addiction.
 - Prevention low rates of schools participating in Illinois Youth Survey, and lack of understanding regarding the impact of trauma on youth and adults.
 - Harm reduction lack of awareness regarding availability of NARCAN and safe syringes.
 - Intervention and treatment lack of detox and residential facilities, lack of internet access (25% do not have it in MT), lack of reliable transportation.
 - Recovery lack of reliable transportation, lack of secular recovery support groups like smart recovery, lack of recovery housing and local housing options.
- O Common gaps in all counties surveyed:
 - Recovery housing
 - What are other states doing?
 - Drug Court programs
 - Tool Kit for landlords
 - Oxford House
 - Christian county received a grant from local hospital to provide recovery housing
 - Stigma
 - Types of stigma
 - What does that look like here?
 - Stigma Tool Kit
 - Educational materials and campaigns
 - Transportation
 - What are other states doing?
 - Examine limitations of managed care transportation programs
 - Development of training materials for volunteer programs.
- O Brainstorming worksheet handed out.

 Senator Turner expressed her interested and suggested we can start working with Blake Meyer.
