

# **Today's Discussion:**

- After introductions, Dan quickly reviewed what the McLean ROSC is in very high level terms: A
  community coalition of volunteers, professionals, people with lived experience (PLEs), family, and
  concerned citizens who are committed to providing coordinated, holistic recovery-oriented supports
  and services to all our community's recovery people (SUD, Mental Health, Rentry, Abuse, etc.). This
  was review for most but establishing this baseline may be helpful to newer members
- **Note:** Recovery Community Center = RCC; Person with Lived Experience = PLE; Recovery Community Organization = RCO; Recovery Oriented System of Care = ROSC
- Bruce Lang (Prairie Pride Coalition) was the first presenter to share about three different groups that
  cater to different people within the LGBTQIA+ community—those seeking general support from
  substance use disorders, young people, and adults living with disabilities.

- 1. **Queer Support Group:** Bruce reported this mutual support group held its first meeting last week with a promising turnout.
- **2. Friends Like Us Youth Group** (see below; ~13-19 years old, meets at static location and has been together as a group for several years).
- **3. Rainbows of Steel:** Support for people living at the intersection between LGBTQ and disabilities. Bruce stated these groups are looking for facilitators (may require background check, especially if for youth program). - The McLean Country Reentry Council: Coordinated community response to address prisoner reentry and recidivism. The council is comprised of justice-involved individuals, criminal justice officials, health, and human service providers who work together to reduce recidivism in McLean County. One of the goals of the council is to support individuals and their families who have been impacted by detention and incarceration. Toy spoke to the value of re-entry support and described it as "a different type of trauma". He also provided the following updates about upcoming events:
  - Re-Entry Fair September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at Eastview Community Center (401 Union Street) from Noon-3pm learn about life skills, how to support and prepare people coming out of jails and institutions, childcare assistance, employment, and more!
