Presentation and Discussion	<ul> <li>Bring harm reduction supplies to people in rural communities who do not have access to transportation.</li> <li>Harm reduction supplies help people who use drugs to use them in a safer way.</li> <li>Supplies are just part of what Phoenix Center does since it helps with outreach, engagement, and dialogue with people with substance use issues.</li> <li>Research shows that involvement with harm reduction programs increases the likelihood of getting treatment.</li> <li>The goal is to provide drug education, creating a safe space, and care coordination.</li> <li>Rachel went over different types of drugs, their effects, withdrawal symptoms, and risks.</li> </ul>
