- Community Partner Updates
 - SMART Recovery in Belleville group meets every Thursday at 12:30, in the Belleville Public Library on West Main Street.
- **Faith-based Initiative Presentation**, Patrick Miller, Chestnut Center for Community Engagement presented an overview of the new project that he is heading. The project is anticipated to be ready for launch in April, 2023, and will provide toolkits for growing Faith-based programming, including: how to form a support group; anti-stigma campaigns; the language of recovery; and resilience. Toolkits will be rolled out over the course of the year. An initial meeting will take place in February 2023 (date TBD).
