

Ford County ROSC Council Meeting Minutes


March 28th, 2023 at 8:30 a.m.

the best place to allocate FY24 funds? The following is the result of Slido Poll voting among 10
voters.





- Open ended Question: Where would you like to see funds allocated in the future? Freeform responses included community trainings, community events, media campaigns, education and awareness, transportation & housing, ROSC Awareness, and more education.
- Frankie thanked the team for participating in the polls and reiterated these types of decisions are best made as a team.
- All Awareness Day Ivy Ward: Ivy shared news about the All Awareness Day on May 13th at
