What is Mentorship:

Some Core Skills a Mentor should display:

Active listening

- Trust/transparency
- · Encouraging/ empowering/motivate
- Inspiring/uplifting
- · Able to provide constructive feedback.
- Respect
- Committed to the Mentee success.
- Ability to identify problems and solutions.
- · Lead by example.
- · Objective/ non bias
- Disciplined/ balanced / focused.
- · Good communication skills

Avoid Toxic Mentoring / Unhealthy Mentoring

Toxic Mentoring or unhealthy Mentoring is defined when the role of the mentor is abused.

- Seeking to control rather than teach.
- · Projecting your life experiences, Traumas, etc. onto the mentee
- · Personal expectations for the mentee
- Not being responsible and or neglecting appointments
- · Abusive language, and or body language



Fact: Mentorship typically a volunteered position. However, organizations and companies has incorporated the position because it has been proven to add more morale and less stress on management.

Mentors in a position can be paid on average 35,581 per year or 17.11 an hour in the United States.
