Alex And Arya explain that various people/organizations will be given awards as recognition by the youth as being a safe space.

What is a Safe Space

Alex and Arya express the powers of what a safe space can do in the community. Creating safe spaces in the community can prevent substance misuse, violence, suicide, harmful behaviors, adverse mental health, homelessness, poverty, fentanyl poisoning, things that hurt our peers, or stop them from being the amazing humans. If youth have a safe space to communicate what is going on then prevention work can soon follow.
