ROSC builds on the strengths and resilience of individuals, families, and communities to achieve abstinence and improve health, wellness, and quality of life for those with or at risk of substance misuse problems.

The overall goal is to develop an integrated recovery system for those seeking substance use and mental health treatment by involving the community to improve the availability of services. ROSC also seeks to destigmatize substance use and mental health disorders through this shared vision.
