Presentation and Discussion	<p>Derrek Tiburzi, Macoupin County Department of Transportation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Complete restructure of transportation program, with full list of changes included in meeting's PowerPoint. ○ Moved to more of a personal service than true public transportation dept. ○ No more monthly or annual passes. ○ Effective 7/1 fare rates have increased. ○ Seniors will ride for free. ○ Non-medical rides 6 miles or less are \$5 flat rate and +65 cents a mile. 7 miles or more are \$10 flat with +65 center a mile. ○ Medicaid reimburses for services. ○ QR code at the bottom of page where you can submit feedback. ○ Incorporating loop routes soon which will be \$10 a day and you can ride as much as you can. ○ Designated bus stop and looks like hub and spoke model. Will include a Litchfield destination. <p>Jon Magnuson, The Next Network</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Recently received a grant and bought van to offer transportation services ○ The rides are to and from treatment, and for outpatient and medical appts. ○ Traveled 616 miles for 4 rides. 8 hours of peer recovery support. Cheaper than uber and average cost is \$1 mile. <p>Q: Transport minors? A: As of right now no, but happy to look into it with insurance company.</p> <p>Q: What counties are you serving? A: Montgomery and Macoupin.
