The topic of discussion: Talked about boundaries in the workplace and personal boundaries and how to manage those boundaries. Amanda passed out worksheets on boundaries. Also discussed recovery housing and our plans to get that started. We have the green light to go through with a house but legally we need to figure out what we can and cannot do.

Jacquelynn and Holly talked to us about the learn meeting held in Jacksonville that is open to anyone. Memorial Hospital in Jacksonville holds this meeting at the Police Department. Erica Provolone runs the meeting. The next meeting is scheduled for Friday, July 21, 2023. Heather asked if this was similar or if it was the same as the interagency meeting I just learned about. These are two different meetings. The interagency meeting is for community members who share updates about their work and distribute flyers for upcoming events. The Learn Meeting is more for agencies in the community within all counties in the area who have mutual clients, and everyone can discuss how clients are doing with a signed consent to do so.

The group continued the discussion discussing the various interventions we can do as a group with regard to housing support. Some of the topics discussed was clinical treatment, peer support expansion, employment assistance and more. The group used lived experience stories to relate to the topic and shared the various challenges each of them experienced and discussed how these lived experiences relate to the need for meaningful change. <These stories are redacted for privacy>
