Welcome and Introductions

 A ROSC definition was provided for new members. Shara added that the Franklin Williamson ROSC council is continually building, and the Council is made up from various sectors of the community. Presentation:

Stephanie Cima, TASC Supervisor for (SI CERT) -Southern Illinois Community Engagement Response Team, she is over 13 counties.

Stephanie stated that SERT takes but is not limited to referrals from Law Enforcement. They use deflection to keep individuals out of the Justice System.

Requirements: 18 yr. and older.

Some of the services:

- Assistance with navigating resources, such as financial aid from DHS, I.D., Govt. Phones.etc.
- No time limit on engagement
- Relentless Engagement includes contact once or twice a week, building trust, finding treatment, getting individuals to Doctor's appointments, seeking stable housing, things as simple as bug spray for those who live in tents.
- They work with community agencies for resourcing such as, Southern IL Coalition for the Homeless and Warming Center, etc.

Stephanie said she was excited about joining the ROSC, so we can all work together for the good of the communities we serve in.
