Introduced new people: first explained purpose of meeting (action group), everyone introduced themselves

Gaps:

- Housing: Updates on Housing: Will have someone from Centerstone talk about recovery transitional housing, found a grant today as well focused on rural communities

 working with landlords in the area to develop agreements – Pathways to Removing Obstacles - HUD
 - o Jon M. majority of my clients people that need housing the most federally subsidized housing not great for them because disqualified lots of houses that go up for auction can find decent home for \$10-12 K get livable nice standard for \$10/12K have lead agency be in charge can do month to month leases wants to find around \$50 K in funding. If had 1 or 2 homes in Litchfield could be manageable administratively.
 - Only housing available are hotels and Air-BNBs
 - Taylor B. talked about creating a community of "tiny houses."
 - Next step: Put on agenda of community wellness committee which will get around \$700K per year.
- Engagement: We are required to hit a variety of different stakeholder sectors.
 Continuing to have difficulty getting police involvement. We learned at the statewide meeting that we don't necessarily have to have them at the table just how you are working with them that connects to what they are doing.
 - Asked police dept. if have safety needle containers in their cars
 - Is there a chiefs meeting that we can join and count as a "PLE" to bring their perspectives back to the ROSC.
 - Last week there was a mayor's meeting at county board chair occasionally county mayors' meetings - that is an open meeting. We need to consider joining.
 - Sheriff Robins does have chief meetings occasionally but generally not open to the public
 - Is there a police liaison that represents the police department with the community that we can join?
 - O Discuss the idea of using a "group me" "what's up" texts to provide quick systems for referral response. Have someone from every facility/program agree to be on that app. We can work on a way to get that service faster via ROSC. We can utilize Michelle (Recover corps Project coordinator).
- Stigma: Michelle is going to be project coordinator for Americorps will start on the 3rd. She is going to be working at SFW but want ROSC to utilize her she will be engaging in community events

- Community Wellness community talked about doing surveys in the community can use Michelle for.
- Kevin Schott spoke about tomorrow night's event with Chris Fields who was a firefighter who carried baby out of Oklahoma bombing got a lot of attention he went through hell, was an alcoholic, got divorced will share his message. A woman from Nokomis will also speak on suicide. Encourage anyone to come open to everybody at the event center in Hillsboro at 6 PM. Welcome to put tables up as well.
- Flyer State of IL grant through Fire Marshalls office community risk committee – morphing into a locked. They do mental health programs through their fire department. They do this through city fire dep – want to do county wide. Will share at next community wellness meeting.
- Deliverables: non due at this time. We have already submitted for end of October
- Transportation: no updates
- Drug Take Back Day October 28th this coming Saturday anything to do as a council?
 Last year had advertised to community and partnered with Michelle's pharmacy all were entered into raffle and drew at the end of the week

- Have folders ready to go for new members what we have done, what we are working towards – what a ROSC do generally
 - What mission is? ROSC definition now includes mental health
