Purpose of the Community Outreach Plan: This plan explains the in-depth process of how the EfCRC will provide outreach to their community and implement the concept of ROSC.

Outreach Goals:

- 1. Continue to maintain and engage Effingham County ROSC Council through monthly ROSC meeting.
- **2.** Implement and utilize Advisory subcommittee to gather real life experience and ideas for ROSC Council future goals (December 2023.)
- **3.** Engage in 1:1 meeting with local stakeholders and community members to build SUD awareness and identify community gaps or barriers related to recovery resources.
- **4.** Assist in building SUD awareness in the community by providing additional SUD resources, education, events, and discussion opportunities.
- **5.** Develop additional recovery support opportunities, SUD treatment resources, local essential resources, and sober events for persons in recovery and their families.
- 6. Increase awareness and information for health promotion around harm reduction and recovery services including Recovery Navigators/Peer Support Specialists in the area.
- 7. Hold bi-monthly ROSC hosted event for recovery community to promote sober, familyoriented activities and fun.

Outreach Objectives:

- 1.a. Continue monthly ROSC Council meetings.
- 1.b. Remain in consistent communication with ROSC Council members.
 - Send meeting minutes within 3 business days of each Council meeting.
 - Send reminder of Council meeting 1 week prior.
 - Send additional Council meeting reminder 3 days prior.
 - Follow up with members via email, phone, or in-person meetings.

2.a. Hold monthly Advisory subcommittee meetings.

- Remind members of Advisory meeting via phone, email, and in-person at local recovery meetings throughout the month.
- Send meeting minutes within 3 business days of each Advisory meeting.
- Delegate meeting minute taker (December 2023.)
- Bring ideas and suggestions of Advisory meeting to ROSC Council meeting members and follow through with requests (if applicable.)
- 3.a. Recruit 2+ people to represent each stakeholder sector or category.

- Attend local coalition meetings, community meetings and events to identify possible champions of the community/stakeholder sector.
- Consult with Council members to assist in identifying gaps in these sectors.

3.b. Monitor retention of community stakeholders each month.

- Document Council member participation in the Effingham County ROSC Membership activity log.
- Follow up with inactive members to re-engage.

4.a. Coordinate/facilitate events in which key stakeholders and people with lived experience are able to come together and discuss potential gaps/barriers in Effingham County via 1:1 interaction or sharing of PLE testimonies.

4.b. Coordinate/facilitate collaboration between key stakeholders within the county in order to better serve people in recovery.

4.c. Conduct the Hidden in Plain Sight Event at participating local high schools (if applicable)- Effingham, Teutopolis, Altamont.

5.a. Collaborate with local SUD treatment organizations/individuals.

- Create a relationship/partnership with Heartland Human Services.
- Continuously identify SUD counselors in community and conduct 1:1 meetings to facilitate partnership with ROSC.
- 5.b. Coordinate efforts to provide MAR in Effingham County jail.
 - Bring necessary MAR information in regards to education and funding to Effingham County Sheriff.
 - Include Gentle Care Consultants in coordination of MAR practices in Effingham County in regards to the jail.
- 5.c. Coordinate efforts to provide transportation for recovery related events/appointments.
 - Communicate with CIPT and attend transportation advisory meetings to advocate for additional transportation resources (Ongoing FY24.)
 - Examine the Rural Transportation Toolkits developed by the statewide ROSC.
 - Include CIPT in discussions of transportation to/from locations of local recovery events.
 - Include CIPT bus pass accessibility from the Health Department on Laundry Day flyers.

5.d. Coordinate efforts for Early Intervention educational resources to be brought into local schools- K-12.

- Perform Narcan training at TriStar Academy and Aspire High School (September 2023.)
- Bring educational material to such events and available resources for school officials to access and utilize.
- Continue to reach out to local school officials to educate on ROSC concept.

5.e. Provide information campaigns to reduce stigma and provide support to persons with substance use disorders.

- Lease County specific billboard for FY24 to promote "Recovery Is Possible."
- Distribute state and national information campaigns.
- Coordinate local resource information campaigns as needed.

- Participate in area health and wellness resource fairs and information campaigns.
- Distribute ROSC information brochures and treatment related resources.
- Collaborate with the Hour House Prevention Team and Illinois Family Resource Center.
- Provide SUD related webinar and additional training information to council members.
- Increase awareness of SUD in Effingham County during local events.

6.a. Increase awareness and information for health promotion around harm reduction and services.

- Provide information on the ROSC social media page on where/how to access harm reduction services and programs.
- Work with partnering agencies to share social media posts and educational materials.
- Identify additional needs in the community to expand access to Narcan, Safe Needles, Fentanyl Test Strips, and other resources.
- Partner with the Effingham County Health Department to increase distribution and training for Narcan.
- Provide stakeholders updates on harm reduction services, supplies and resource guides.

6.b. ROSC Council will provide support for the Problem-Solving Court in Effingham County.

• Engage and offer coordination of fundraising events for STAR.

6.c. ROSC Council will provide support and education to the Effingham City Safe Passage Program and assess gaps of program if needed.

6d. Determine locations in Effingham County for Recovery Navigator to meet with clients.

- Communicate with ROSC Council to determined safe meetings places for clients.
- Allocate at least 5 safe meeting spots within Effingham County.

6.e. Distribute Recovery Navigator referral forms via resource folders and during 1:1 meeting with organizations, businesses, and PLEs.

6.f. Attempt contact with referral within 48 hours of Recovery Navigator being notified via ROSC supervisor or County coordinator.

6.g. Recovery Navigator will assist in the development of an "All Recovery" meeting in the county.

7.a. ROSC Council & Advisory committee with collaborate for ideas for sober recovery events.

• Ask Advisory committee what they'd like to see happen in their community Assess resources to hold such requests via Council & developed community partnerships.
