- 3. Sub Committee Reports: (we need people to serve on committees and help with our work!!)
 - A. **Education & Prevention** Heather Creasy-Chairperson:
 - Illinois Youth Survey update: As of 11/21/23, we have 4 schools signed up: Bartelso Elementary, Willow Grove Elementary, Carlyle High School & Germantown Elementary. For the data to count, we need more schools to sign up! A suggestion was made to ask D.A.R.E. officers to ask schools to do the IYS. Also discussed putting a summary of the 2022 IYS data in local newspapers so parents and community can see results. Craig brought up a comment Judge Gruenke made to him at Celebrate Life event: "....75% of crime is related to substance use; ½ of the other 25% is indirectly related..." Prevention benefits our community.
 - Too Good For Drugs program offered by HYFS in now in Breese and Okawville Elementary. Program available for more Clinton and Washington County schools to participate in. Contact HYFS.

 - Statewide Semiannual Overdose Report, IDPH-October 2023 (see attached)
 - Fentanyl is now in 7 out of 10 pills!! Was 4 of 10, then 6 of 10. Community education is needed, especially with youth.

 - C. Treatment & Recovery Cara Loddeke/Alicia Moesner Co-Chairpersons (not present but sharing info):
 - TASC-Permanent Supportive Housing Program: reached out to this group but our contact has left employment and a new person is coming on. Will try to reach out to them again to see if they could come to a future meeting to talk about their program.
 - Brainstorm free places we could host PLE Advisory Group meetings that don't serve alcohol or have gambling
