<u>Overview</u>

What is ROSC?

ROSC is a coordinated network of community-based services and supports that is person-centered and builds on the strengths and resiliencies of individuals, families, and communities to achieve recovery and improved health, wellness, and quality of life for those with or at risk of substance use disorders. The central focus of a ROSC is to create an infrastructure, or "system of care", with the resources to effectively address the full range of substance use problems within communities.

Mission: We will build and empower communities of recovery by developing a council comprised of recovery allies, community leaders and people with lived experience working together to reduce the stigma surrounding substance use and other co-occurring disorders, while embodying the philosophy that there are countless pathways to recovery.

Vision: To sustain recovery support within the community by unity and intentional collaboration among all allies, stakeholders, and those in or seeking recovery.
