LIVINGSTON ROSC BUILDS & DISTRIBUTES HYGIENE BAGS

With the assistance of Handles of Hope, IHR, Livingston County Health Department, Project OZ, Livingston County Mental Health Board, Salvation Army, and more, the ROSC has assembled and distributed over 100 bags for individuals in need. Each bag contains personal hygiene items, winter hats, gloves, snacks, NARCAN®, and resource information.

ROSC SUBCOMMITTEE EXPANSION

Individuals and service agencies within the ROSC council have joined together to form an Educating for Change committee to address the need for stigma reduction around Substance Use Disorder and co-occurring mental health challenges.
