Meeting Minutes - BB2L ROSC Council

Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Apostle Carl White.

Attendance Registration:

Welcome and Introductions:

- Pastor Fleshman welcomed all attendees, introducing the purpose of the discussion.
- Pastor Fleshman invited each attendee to provide a brief introduction, highlighting their roles within the BB2L ROSC Council.

Introduction of Pastor Steve Jones:

Summary of Grief Sharing:

Pastor Jones shared with the group that group grief counseling helps reduce depression symptoms in people after losing a loved one. Group grief therapy, available in-person and online, helps you build connections with others who are grieving and might positively impact your mental health. People often enter a period of grief after losing a loved one, but everyone experiences grief differently. You might feel intense anger, fear, or sadness. Losing a loved one is often a traumatic experience, and grief can be long-lasting. The goal of group grief counseling is to reduce the mental and physical effects of grief to help you move forward. Hearing about others' experiences can give you an idea of how long it takes and how disruptive it can be. He emphasized that you may feel hopeful if you see others in later time frames of their grief function in ways that seem unfathomable after you lose someone. Many people are not comfortable sharing their feelings with family and friends. A grief support group may provide an outlet if you desire to talk to others but do not know where to go. Pastor Jones stated the grieving process can feel lonely. It might help to see that others are going through similar life changes as you are, though differently.

Participant Opinions and Testimonies:

- Several opinions were shared regarding the powerful and helpful nature of the presentation to various agencies and stakeholders.
- Multiple attendees shared their experiences with grief sharing and how it helped them on their healing journey.
