## 2. Overview of ROSC and Meeting Objectives

- Lisa Blackwell provided an overview of **Recovery-Oriented Systems of Care (ROSC)** and its mission in **Coles County** to assist individuals and families affected by substance use disorder (SUD).
- Goals for the meeting:
  - Strengthening Coles County's recovery supports
  - Increasing community collaboration
  - Sharing organizational updates and resources
  - Promoting education and awareness
  - o Identifying community needs and challenges

#### 3. Guest Speaker: Jasmine Gast – Lived Experience

- Jasmine Gast, Recovery Navigator for Coles County, shared her personal journey of recovery.
- Highlights of her story:
  - Clean date: August 4, 2022.
  - Grew up in **foster care** and struggled with addiction from an early age.
  - Began substance use at 15 following a knee surgery and later progressed to methamphetamine use.
  - Became a **mother at 19** while still in active addiction.
  - Eventually sought treatment and recovery, which transformed her life.
  - Now works in **community outreach** to support others in recovery.
- Jasmine emphasized that long-term recovery is possible with support, resources, and community connection.

## 4. Community Recovery Efforts & Initiatives

#### A. Education & Outreach Programs

- Jasmine provided updates on **community education classes**:
  - February's topic: Healthy Relationships (Valentine's Day theme).
  - March's topic: Money Management & Recovery (St. Patrick's Day theme).
  - Classes are currently held at the **library**, but new **location options** are being considered to increase attendance.

#### **B.** Community Laundry Days

- Initiative to provide **free laundry services** for people in need.
- Currently, **\$200 has been raised**, but more donations (monetary, detergent, dryer sheets) are needed.
- Potential laundromat locations being considered in Mattoon and Charleston.

#### C. Upcoming Event: Together in Tune – Recovery Jam

- Scheduled for March 20th, 1:30-4:30 PM.
- Features:
  - Live music & open mic.
  - Free coffee and snacks.
  - **Community resources & education** on ROSC.
- Goal: Celebrate recovery, reduce stigma, and increase community engagement.

#### **D.** Additional Planned Events

- Recovery Grub Fest A summer event featuring local food vendors and recovery education.
- Bring Your Own Mug (BYOM) Coffee Events A sober alternative gathering at local coffee shops with photography & community voting for the best mug.
- **EIU Bowling Night** Engaging college students in recovery awareness.
- Faith & Community Subcommittee New subcommittee promoting faith-based recovery events, including prayer in the park and interfaith collaborations.

#### 5. Review of Previous Meeting Minutes & Community Resources

- Meeting minutes from the previous council meeting were reviewed and approved by Kandace Mills.
- Community Asset Map:
  - Lists recovery-related resources in Coles County.
  - Lisa requested members to submit additional resources to keep the map updated.
- Discussion on Community Needs:
  - Need for **better transportation options** for those seeking treatment.
  - **Proposed idea**: Creating a **transportation resource list** (including local volunteers).
  - Concern that recovery housing beds are available but not well-known.
  - Solution: Develop a centralized list of recovery housing with availability tracking.

6. Community Survey & Needs Assessment

- Survey results provided important insights into Coles County's recovery needs.
- Key findings:
  - Increased demand for recovery housing.
  - **Ongoing stigma** prevents some individuals from seeking help.
  - Need for additional outreach to underserved communities.
- Strategic Plan in Development:
  - Based on the survey data & needs assessment, a strategic plan is being created.
  - **Members encouraged** to share ideas for the plan before submission at the end of the month.

# 7. Open Discussion & Additional Updates

- New Ideas & Future Initiatives:
  - **Recovery Resource Fair**: A proposed **gathering of recovery organizations** and treatment providers.
  - More collaboration with sober living homes and transportation providers.
- Social Media Outreach:

- Members encouraged to follow and share the Coles County ROSC Facebook page to increase awareness.
- Organizations can submit updates for posting on ROSC's page and newsletter.

### 8. Next Meeting & Guest Speaker

- Next Meeting Date: April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2025
- Guest Speaker: Representatives from BASE Program (Build, Amplify, Support, Empower)
  - BASE works with at-risk youth in school settings using intervention programs.
