Do you know that April is National Alcohol Awareness month?

April is Alcohol Awareness Month, an opportunity to update your knowledge about alcohol use disorder (AUD) and the adverse impact of alcohol misuse on health and society. Alcohol-related problems continue to take a heavy toll on individuals, families, and communities. Researchers estimate that each year there are more than 178,000 alcohol-related deaths, making alcohol a leading preventable cause of death in the United States. In addition, more than 200 disease and injury-related conditions are associated with alcohol misuse. – National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism. Here are a few facts about Alcohol!

- Alcohol affects your brain and body
- Ethanol is the most popular psychoactive addictive substance
- Binge drinking is dangerous
- Alcohol has a negative impact on your hormones
- Alcohol misuse has a genetic component
- Some drinks contain more pure alcohol than you think
- Alcohol withdrawal symptoms range from mile to serious


