c. Community enrichment group—Both enrichment groups are going great! We had 10 on Thursdays and 10 on Sundays. Two people were 60 days sober, and one was 90 days sober! We have great news: Next school year, we will be doing an enrichment group at Clinton High School.

Guest speakers Piatt County Mental Health- Tony Kirkman talked about challenges for prevention, including limited funding and a lack of a significant workforce. Tony discussed the criminal legal system as a high-impact setting for interventions to address the overdose crisis. He presented provisional drug overdose data for 12 months, showing a decline in deaths from 112,910 in October 2023 to 84,076 in October 2024, thanks in part to Naloxone. However, there are still a lot of deaths. Tony also talked about our new grant year starting in July and ways to continue hosting sober events, with the help of the 708 to keep ROSC going. The council came up with ideas to host more events.
