HARM REDUCTION

516 Boxes of Narcan distributed

20 DOPP Sites

5 New DOPP sites

Provided Narcan Trainings at the Arcola Food Pantry, Family Health Center, Lazy Day Cafe, Arthur United Methodist Church, and Hometown Grounds Coffee & Events.

Three Barney Narcan newspaper stand distribution boxes placed (Road Ranger in Tuscola, Douglas County Sheriff's Office, and Country Salvage Store in Arcola).

RECOVERY RESOURCE ACCESS

Created and distributed ROSC Resource Quick Guides throughout the county at over 24 locations.

Monthly newsletter & recovery resources available at all Narcan sites, monthly meetings, and on social media

100+ hygiene bags distributed. 50 resource bags given to the unhoused in Douglas County.

Distributed Recovery literature to 7 libraries.

ROSC hosted the housing subcommittee made up of community members who are passionate about the housing project. During the meetings members discussed how to continue to make the community aware of the project, generated ideas for fundraising, and shared funding opportunities.
