



Edgar County ROSC FY25 Impact Report



HARM REDUCTION AWARENESS

- Distributed 943 Boxes of Narcan through our Narcan DOPP sites
- Partnered with local businesses to add 3 new DOPP sites
- Attended EMS Night and provided a community-wide pop-up Narcan training
- Hosted a community wide Understanding “Addiction and Harm Reduction” training

STIGMA REDUCTION

- County-wide anti-stigma campaign: **“We Can and Do Recover”**
- Hosted **16** different Recovery-oriented events
- Hosted 11 free laundry days, helped **245** individuals complete **804** wash cycles and **757** dry cycles

RECOVERY HOUSING

- Assisted local First Responders and Law Enforcement with implementation of a warming shelter while providing resources to the guests
- Currently assisting the Doorway to Hope to obtain a 501C3 status to open a community center/overnight shelter in Edgar County

RECOVERY RESOURCE ACCESS

- Dispersed over 100 recovery resource folders to local judicial system
- Provided local EMS with 75 overdose prevention health and hygiene bags
- Working with Horizon Health to implement a warm hand-off program
- Hosted 2nd Annual Recovery Picnic with 100 people in attendance
- Weekly resource distribution and support outreach at Helping Hands Soup Kitchen
