Stigma Reduction

- Sectors primarily served this FY: Healthcare, Youth-serving agencies, Education (9-12th grade), Community-serving agencies, Faith-based, Behavioral health, Parents & families, 12-step programs
- O Facebook lives + radio with Premier Broadcasting; 4 months of radio ads for Red Ribbons week, Prevention week, and ROSC events
- 769 Facebook followers since Nov. 2023 (increase of 500 in FY25)
- 65,000+ views of posts, videos, stories, or ads (per month on average)
- Creation of South Side Subcommittee to reach family members of those affected with SUD (Edgewood & Mason area)

- 100+ connections to local resources including food, transportation, clothing, housing, employment, recovery meetings, SUD/MH treatment options, & harm reduction materials (primarily family members of those affected by SUD, problem-solving court, behavioral health agencies, Celebrate Recovery)
