Key Approvals

Support groups, upcoming events, and ROSC member updates.

- ROSC's upcoming event Setting Sobriety Spike- Recovery Sand Volleyball and Cookout on June 11th 6PM-7PM
- **Bright Futures** shared discussion about resources provided to Greene County. They are resources for parents. Important notes- they help with car seat safety, diaper bank (Monday 11-1 2xs per month), formula bank (emergency only), and help make sure family and relationships are healthy. They set goals based on what the family needs and help them along the way. Everyone who qualifies call (217) 374-6579, website northgreene.com under building tab. 110 families a year! They also discussed their upcoming events- May 28th @5:00-6:30 PM. They are having an end of the year bash and touch a truck Event, and 30th Annual Kids Fishing Derby June 7th 9am- Noon at Roodhouse Lake 16 & under. Also, a free lunch will be served.

• The Crisis Center Foundation- shared discussion on upcoming Back to School Bash Aug 9th 11am-2pm at Minnie Barr Park 300 E. Walnut, Jacksonville IL. They will have vendors, basic school supplies, food, music, a bounce house, and so much more.

New Initiatives and Updates:

- We are currently waiting to confirm the availability of a volunteer to provide free back-to-school haircuts for youth in need.
- DCFS will be contacted to ensure they are informed about our ROSC efforts and opportunities for collaboration.
- Life Skills programming has officially launched in partnership with the Drug Court Team, helping participants build critical competencies for long-term recovery and stability.
- Discussions also focused on navigating legal challenges faced by individuals in recovery and identifying local, community-based resources for ongoing support. These efforts are already making a meaningful impact and directly reflect the shared mission of our ROSC: to build a comprehensive, person-centered recovery network.

Supply Closet & Donations:

 The ongoing need for donations to stock our supply closet was emphasized. This resource remains essential to breaking down everyday barriers that hinder recovery by ensuring individuals have access to basic hygiene and personal care items.

Additional Council Actions and Discussions:

- Planning has begun for interagency meetings in both Greene and Scott Counties. These meetings aim to strengthen cross-sector collaboration and improve service coordination across agencies.
- The Council agreed to begin publicly displaying monthly ROSC service data through Facebook posts and printed flyers. This move is intended to enhance transparency and community engagement.
- A monthly ROSC Council Planning Committee meeting will be scheduled at the beginning of each month to organize efforts, establish priorities, and increase the overall effectiveness of our initiatives.
