## **Todays Business**

- Kristen Peterson: OBK, Our Brothers Keepers of Southern Illinois | Prison Ministry and Re-Entry located in E. St. Louis 614 N. 7th St. operating for about 10 years. Has been helping people who are getting out of state prison, with reentry services. These services are not mandated but voluntary so the level of motivation from participants tends to be high. They assist with efforts focused on untreated MH and SUD and makes connections with community-based providers (OBK does not provide these services directly). However they do provide AA meetings Tuesdays at noon (also open to the community). They also work with Federal prison cts if they lived in IL before incarceration and plan to live in IL after release these referrals come from the probation office. Covering 18 different service areas: help find housing, obtaining birth certificate, ID, bus passes, clothing, hygiene kits, peer mentoring, employment assistance with specific employers who provide opportunities (Tyson Chicken, Flying J are two main ones), life skills, work with emotional support dogs, etc. The recidivism rate is 6.8 percent for those who are engaging in the program. If participants do return to jail/prison, OBK keeps in touch 3-4 times per year and works to reconnect when they are released again.
