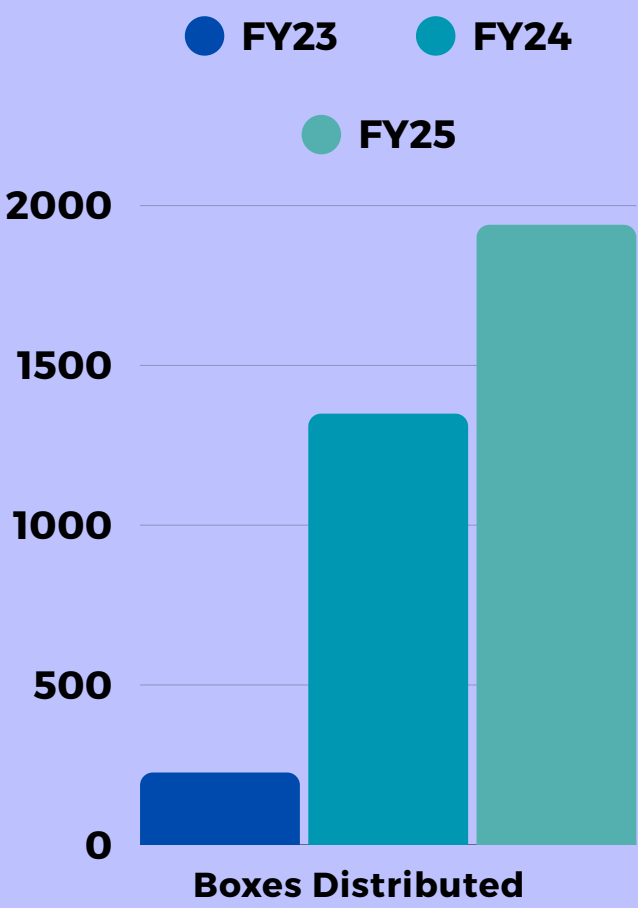

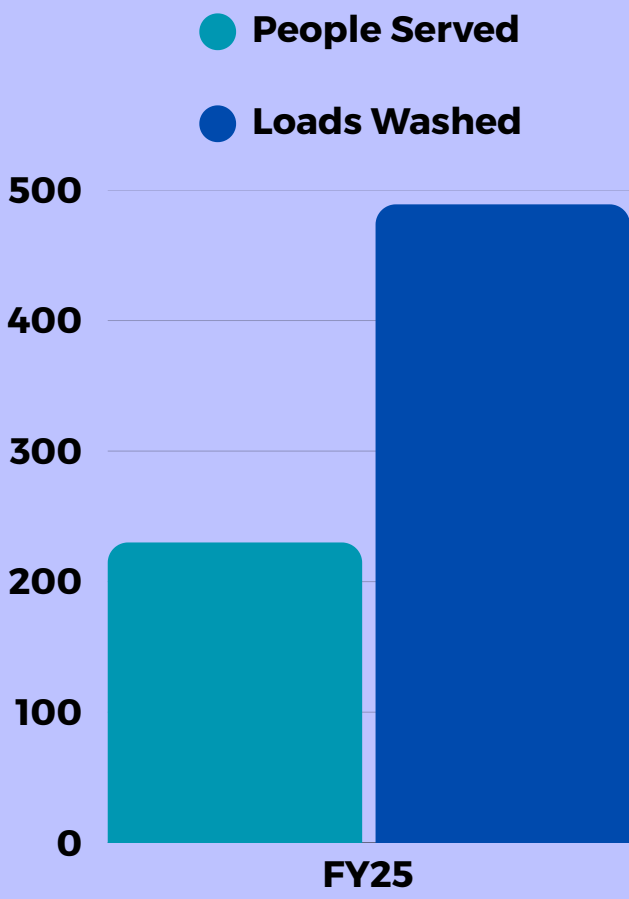
Promote Harm Reduction

Narcan Distribution



By distributing Narcan, we have helped reduce stigma in our community, encouraging open conversations and greater acceptance of harm reduction approaches for those affected by substance use disorder. This initiative has also provided a new level of partnership with local businesses that have distribution boxes placed at their location.

Laundry Events



Our Laundry Day Events have increased awareness of our ROSC's work. We have received several sponsorships and donations from local organizations to continue these events. These events create connection in a welcoming and supportive environment while also providing information on available resources and ROSC initiatives.

Community Outreach & Sober Social Events

Massac County Recovery Walk

An annual event held in September for Recovery Month aimed at celebrating recovery and raising awareness to the multiple pathways that make it possible. It creates a sense of unity within our community by bringing together local agencies and organizations who come out to show their support.

Sober Bowling

Open to the community and held annually, this event seeks to promote social connection by providing a healthy and safe environment for individuals in recovery and their families to enjoy a night of bowling, arcade games, and interact with others in the community. This creates an environment in which stigma is reduced through interaction and information made available.

Overdose Awareness

Our local event observes the internationally recognized day set aside to remember and honor lives lost overdose, raise awareness of the issue to reduce stigma, and share hope with those who have lost loved ones. This event brings together community leaders from law enforcement, local government, and the faith-based community.

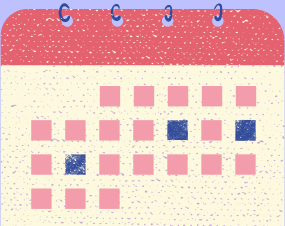
Recovery Council Outings
