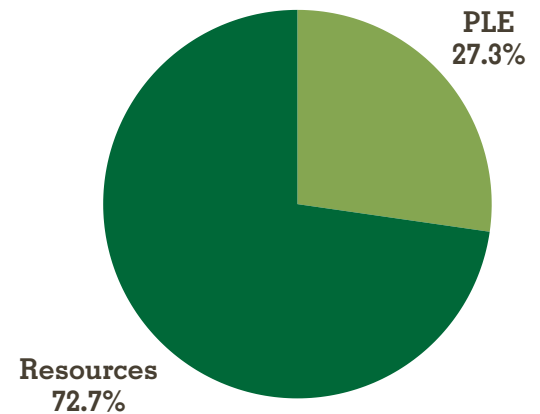

### Council Priorities

Our Council's stigma reduction efforts led Southern Seven Health Department and RISE Community Market to become Recovery Friendly Employers, supporting employment for individuals in recovery. By engaging in events like Family Reading Night and local festivals, we brought recovery conversations into natural community spaces, helping reduce stigma. Collaboration with youth-serving organizations and service providers strengthened community connections. Partnerships with health agencies from St. Louis and Springfield expanded access to recovery services through their participation in Council meetings and health fairs. These efforts reflect a growing network of community and regional support for recovery.
