Impact by Goals

Goal 1: RCO Development

- We have been collaborating with the Next Network (RCO) from Macoupin county. They are interested in expanding their services into Bond County. We are still working on this project along with our first CRSS employed by the Bond County Health Department.
- We also work closely with the First Baptist Church of Greenville supporting their free clothing program, community dinners., and outreach. They provide our resources, Narcan and personal care items with the help of the Bond County Recovery Council.

Goal 2: Transportation in Rural Communities

- Due to limited transportation options in our rural community, we have been able to provide gas cards to PLE's who volunteer to provide transportation to treatment and recovery meetings.
- We also collaborated with the FM Church to secure a free shuttle to provide transportation to three Recovery Events outside our county.

Goal 3: Stigma Reducation

 Monique and Toni joined the Ministerial Alliance this year and were able to provide anti stigma training, Narcan training, participate in events with the faith based community such as a teacher appreciation breakfast, Day of Prayer event, and Good Friday luncheon. All of these were attended by PLE's from our Advisory Board.
