

Our Council's stigma reduction efforts led Southern Seven Health Department to become a Recovery Friendly Employer, supporting meaningful employment opportunities for individuals in recovery. Through active participation in community events such as Back to School nights, Trunk or Treats, and Fall Festivals, Council members and staff provided education on available recovery resources and helped normalize conversations around substance use and mental health in everyday settings. These events strengthened trust and visibility within the community while reducing stigma. Additionally, partnerships with health agencies from the St. Louis and Springfield regions enhanced collaboration and expanded access to recovery services through their engagement in Council meetings and presence at community health fairs. Collectively, these efforts demonstrate a growing regional commitment to supporting recovery and improving community well-being.
