We have been been collaborating with local libraries monthly to engage the communnity with honest and non judgemental conversation about SUD resulting with a mother from a community historically known as a not in our back yard, recieving Narcan and saving her son from an overdose.

Allowed us to partner with local community stakeholders such as St. Clair County probation to make Narcan safety kits available to all probation officers as well as helping Riverbend Ministries in Woodriver get a Narcan distribution box in their lobby along with information for services for SUD and mental health to the unhoused populations

One of several partnerships
that has seen more
individuals is AMARE and it's
recovery coaches, through
this partnership we have
also helped start an early
recovery groups and to help
build healthier foundations
for recovery. One
gentleman stated "the small
groups you have was the
perfect way for me to build
my recovery, I felt heard, I
felt cared for and Im
grateful for all of you."
