Faith-Based Engagement

Held Youth Mental Health Day and partnered with schools for substance use prevention. Supported Seen Disciples Conference to promote youth wellness and early intervention.

Community Engagement

Led ROSC Council meetings, awareness events with HERO Truck, and expanded community involvement by 75%.

Collaborated with ECS to advocate for a new recovery center in Grundy County.

Business & Workforce Engagement

Organized business forums and worked with local chambers to promote recovery-friendly workplaces.

Partnered for job training and mentorships, supporting recovery-to-workforce pipelines.

Recovery Housing & Reentry

Advocated for transitional housing, sober living, and safe reentry support after treatment.

Public Education & Events

Hosted town halls and forums to build awareness and trust across the region.

Ran community service drives for youth and families affected by addiction.

Leadership & Collaboration

Connected faith, health, housing, and workforce sectors.

Expanded reach across Will, Grundy, and Kankakee counties.

Trained clergy, seniors, and congregations to become advocates for recovery.
