- FY26 ROSC Projects Landriah reviewed the following three FY26 Priority Projects for the Shelby County ROSC Council
  - Increase the accessibility and availability of recovery supports with Shelby County, ensuring that individuals in need are aware of, and able to access recovery resources and services.
    - transportation for those in recovery talked about volunteers for recovery vs. medical appointments transportation
    - lack of internet in rural area hurts access online meetings
    - only minimal meetings in person in Shelby County
  - Establish DOPP Sites in the most rural communities of Shelby County for distribution of harm reduction materials.
    - Narcan, Fentanyl test strips, recovery information out to public
    - New DOPP Sites as of August: Shelbyville Public Library, Cowden Gas Station, The Station Bar in Cowden, Lumberyard Bar in Cowden, Herrick Food Mart, Stewardson Gas Station, Strasburg Gas Station, Tower Hill Casey's General Store, Jimmy D's Bar in Tower Hill
    - Goal to have more DOPP Sites in Moweaqua, Findlay, Sigel, Oconee
  - Assist in establishment of a Safe Passage in Shelby County to assist those seeking support and transportation to treatment.
    - Share information with local police, support groups, treatment programs
    - Establish list of volunteers to provide transportation support to those seeking Safe Passage

- Review effectiveness and concerns once program launches
- Survey 3-4 minutes were spent for everyone to fill out their own survey
  - Surveys have been dropped to banks and small towns.
