NARCAN is a medication that can block or reverse the effects of an opioid overdose. Anyone can use NARCAN to save the life of someone overdosing on opioids, including heroin or Community Resource List, updated October 2025

prescription medications like OxyContin® or Percocet®. For training on using NARCAN, contact the Edgar County Health Department at 217-465-2212, HRC at 217-465-4118, or Edgar County ROSC at jessicap@hourhouserecovery.org. If you or someone you know is overdosing, call 911. The Good Samaritan Law protects anyone who calls for help or drops off an individual overdosing from possession charges. However, it does not cover the person who overdosed or any other crime committed at the scene.
