

Near South Side Community Resource List

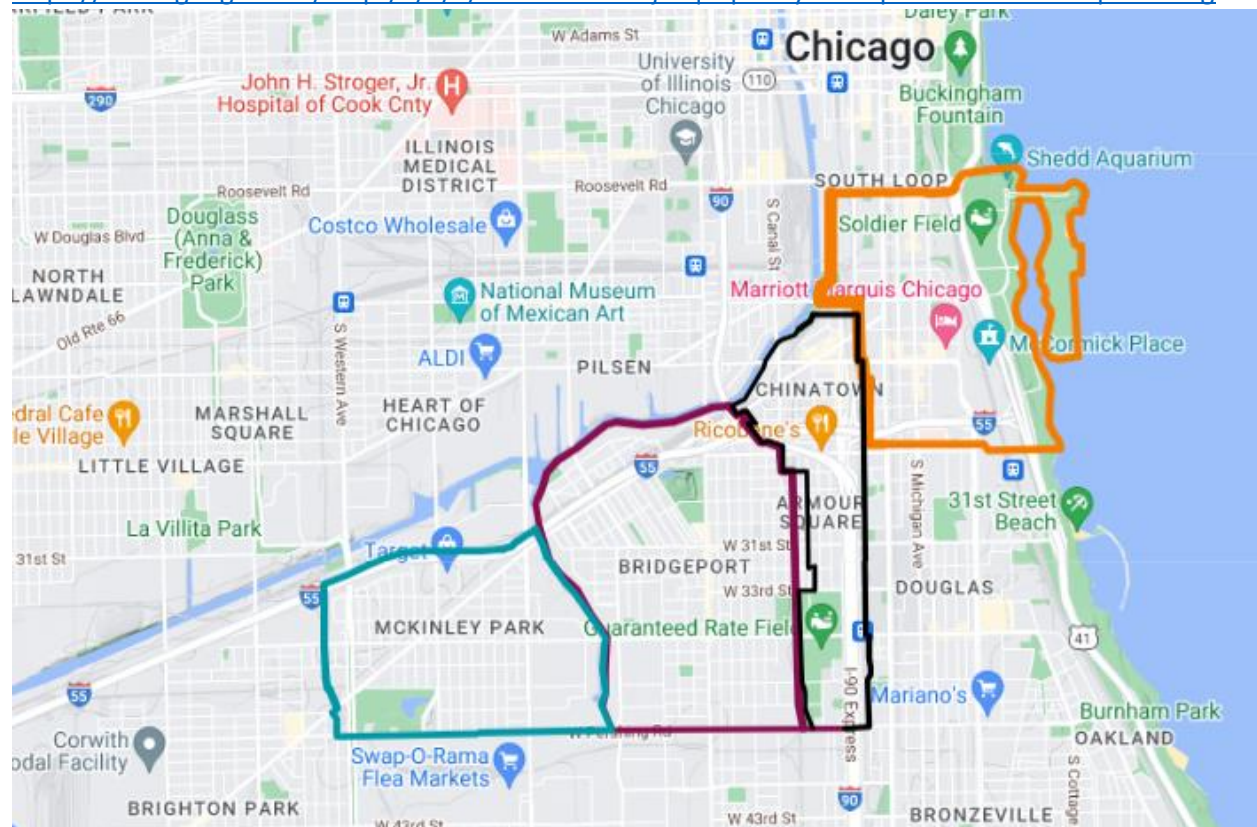
The Community resource list provides information on resources that have been identified in the Near South Side ROSC community neighborhoods (e.g., resources related to recovery support services, housing, employment, vocational training, transportation, independent living, health care, policing, government etc).

We have identified several community resources. 20 locations provide direct medical services to community members seeking access to substance use and mental health support; Access Cabrini Family Health Center, Ashe' Counseling & Coaching LLC, Bridgeport Free Clinic, Chicago Treatment & Counseling Center, China Square Clinic, Chinese American Service League, City Counseling Center, EDDR Foundation, Insight Hospital & Medical Center Chicago, Mck-UDOS, MAHA on 26th Street, MEDTA Immediate Care Clinic, Community Mental Health Clinic, Oak Street Health Chinatown Primary Care Clinic, Pilsen Wellness Center, Pui Tak Center, Restoration Center Chicago, Safe Place Counseling, Soluna Wellness Center, and Wellness Home Behavioral Health
