 - *Increase the accessibility and availability of recovery supports with Shelby County, ensuring that individuals in need are aware of, and able to access recovery resources and services.*
 - **Council shared ideas on where to distribute resource guides – interagency meetings, doctor's offices, hospitals, CEFS Drop Center, Family Life Center**
 - *Establish DOPP Sites in the most rural communities of Shelby County for distribution of harm reduction materials.*
 - New DOPP Site in Oconee
 - Goal to have more DOPP Sites in Moweaqua, Findlay, Sigel
 - **Council shared ideas on new DOPP site locations, Lithia Springs, Silk Purse, The Gift, Findlay Gas Station, The Kazbar, Sigel Fire Dept., libraries.**

- *Assist in establishment of a Safe Passage in Shelby County to assist those seeking support and transportation to treatment.*
