    - Goal to have more DOPP Sites in Moweaqua, Findlay, Sigel
    - Council shared ideas on new DOPP site locations, Lithia Springs, Silk Purse, The Gift, Findlay Gas Station, The Kazbar, Sigel Fire Dept., libraries.

- Assist in establishment of a Safe Passage in Shelby County to assist those seeking support and transportation to treatment.
