West Discussion Highlights

Introductions & Networking

- Shannon reminded everyone to include their name, organization, and email in the chat.
- Participants introduced themselves and shared contact information to support cross-county collaboration between Lee and Whiteside regions.

🎉 Past Events

- RecoverCon was a major success with around 175 attendees and 26 vendors.
- Attendees shared positive feedback, and the event fostered strong community and provider engagement.

📊 Program & Data Updates

- **Gerald Lott** reported **35 intakes** over the last month.
- The **bell curve** of participants is between **ages 35–50**.
- Data trends show a shift toward methamphetamine use, which is proving increasingly difficult to address.

Recovery Friendly Workplace Initiative

- Gerald shared insights from visiting Recovery Community Organizations (RCOs) across the U.S.
 - In Nevada, the Foundation for Recovery trains companies on recovery-supportive policies, like allowing employees to attend meetings.
 - Businesses there receive Recovery Friendly Workplace recognition and tax incentives, though Illinois currently doesn't offer such benefits.
- Gerald emphasized the need to **move from talk to action**, asking, "What do we want to do about it?"

- Discussion points included developing a curriculum for employers to educate them about hiring and supporting people in recovery.
 - Ideas: hire training specialists, define support roles, and ensure advocates are available to mediate workplace issues.
 - Target completion: March 2026.
- **Deanna Cada** suggested connecting with **local Chambers of Commerce** for business engagement.
- A Recovery Friendly Workplace Committee was formed, including Penny, Marta, Erika, and Amanda, to begin planning next steps.

Community & Program Initiatives

Hydroponics Project:

- A meeting is scheduled with Bruce Black at Cledy's House to measure for hydroponic installations at Legacy and Cledy's House.
- Residents will receive training, and the program may be integrated into therapeutic activities.

• Nutrition Education:

 Sara Wright from ISU will be featured on an upcoming flyer promoting nutrition education programs for the community.

Recovery Centers of America (RCA):

 Penny Stark asked how RCA can better support local ROSC efforts, emphasizing her desire to contribute.

• Illinois Youth Survey:

 Marta Jarka encouraged promoting the Illinois Youth Survey to schools, principals, and teachers. Illinois has never published statewide results, and she's checking participation from Ogle and Lee Counties.

• Healthcare Education:

 Marta and Penny discussed the importance of educating urgent cares and ERs about emerging substances like Kratom and Xylazine.
