Healthcare

Central Illinois FRIENDS – (309) 431-5880

• FRIENDS links individuals both infected and affected by HIV/AIDS to essential resources to support longer-term health and supportive services. To receive assistance, you must be living with HIV or AIDS and see a case manager at the University of Illinois College of Medicine at Peoria. If eligible, they can assist with rent payments, utility payments, water payments, and general relief services.

Heartland Health Clinic – (309) 680-7600

• Heartland Health Services is a federally funded clinic whose target population is low-income adults and children. Heartland is not a free clinic but will work with people on a sliding scale that do not have insurance.
