Mandi spoke about all of the programs that are offered in their office-LIHEAP energy assistance, BRP program for helping people remain employed by providing specific supports like boots, weatherization program, free clothing and some housewares, CSGB grant, information on water bill assistance in Villa Grove ([dollarenergyfung.org](http://dollarenergyfung.org)), utility assistance if living in mobile home.

They Salvation Army is looking for volunteers for fundraising efforts and are located in the same building as ERBA in Tuscola. The Salvation Army can help with medication and vouchers to help with specific needs.
