

# **DuPage ROSC Council Meeting Minutes**

DuPage County ROSC Coordinator Jarrett Burton welcomed everyone to the annual DuPage & Kane ROSC Council Holiday party! Jarrett also introduced his colleague Annette Villareal, who is the coordinator for the Kane County ROSC Council, and Annette welcomed their attendees as well.

**DuPage ROSC Coordinator Jarrett Burton** went over the agenda for today's meeting  
Jarrett then promoted some upcoming meetings, events, trainings, etc

**ROSC Coordinator Jarrett Burton** first promoted free psychiatric help available at Serenity House on Wednesdays at Noon—all are welcome regardless of ability to pay.

**ROSC Coordinator Jarrett Burton** then promoted the DuPage Narcan Program and invited Scott Kaufmann to come up and give some updates on the shared Narcan wall-box programs. Scott talked about the importance of the ROSC helping with outreach and helps with some authenticity. Scott talked about the upcoming push to move away from institutions and the larger boxes and into a micro/pop-up model.

Scott also talked about the initiatives to get all of the libraries in DuPage trained in emergency usage and to date we've been able to handle all of the libraries in DuPage County.

ROSC Coordinator Jarrett Burton then announced the next DuPage ROSC Council meeting, which will be held at DuPage County Health Department, and that it will hopefully be the launch of this year's stigma reduction campaign on sober living.

ROSC Coordinator Jarrett Burton then introduced Kane County ROSC Coordinator Annette Villareal, who promoted some things happening in Kane County:

- There is going to be a weekly drop-in center at Serenity House's Geneva location starting January 13<sup>th</sup>, and every Tuesday from Noon to 2pm. There will be warm clothing, resources, services, etc available
- Annette and her team will be collecting donations for the drop-in, but also the new Serenity House harm reduction van
- Annette also asked for donations for pet food, as some unhoused folks have their animals with them
- Jarrett then listed some more items that are helpful including hand-warmers and socks

**ROSC Coordinator Jarrett Burton** then talked about the possibility of starting a post-incarceration fellowship group, which will be non-program specific but more of a drop-in for men who have been released from jail and are looking to forge positive connections.

**ROSC Coordinator Jarrett Burton** then discussed the ongoing yearly Community Needs Surveys that all the ROSCs are conducting, and reminded everyone that the information collected will help to steer the ship and also shows the state what different areas of need may be with data to confirm. The surveys will be going until the end of the month.

**ROSC Coordinator Jarrett Burton** then shouted out Mike Wood from Banyan Treatment Centers for catering the party for everyone

ROSC Coordinator Annette Villareal then introduced the first award winner, which is Kane County Health Department for Organization of the Year and Sharon Cabrera accepted on behalf of the Health Department

Jarrett then introduced the Harm Reduction Organization of The Year, which went to 360 Youth Services for having all of their residences fitted with Narcan wall boxes, and Outreach Coordinator Ezra Fisk accepted on behalf of the organization.

Jarrett then introduced Mark Mathews, the winner of the Lived Experience Award, for all of his work in the community with people who are still struggling.

Annette Villareal then introduced the Kane County Community Champion Award to Sharon Cabrera from the Kane County Health Department

Jarrett then gave out the DuPage County ROSC Community Champion Award to...Scott Kaufmann of the DuPage County Health Department for his tireless efforts as Community Initiatives Coordinator and the essential harm reduction work he's done via the DuPage Narcan Program.

Jarrett and Annette congratulated all the winners once again, and let everyone know that this would be an annual awards show, so people can start thinking about next year's awards!
