

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in English – Draft Pending Curriculum Change Approval

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between College of DuPage (COD) and Governors State University (GovState) for the English degree program based on the current catalogs from both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree with the certificate in Creative Writing from COD and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Communication at GovState.

- Select one Certificate Elective from the approved list (3)
- Select one of the Certificate Capstone Courses (ENGLI 2210, 2261, 2860, or MPTV 1820) (3)
- ENGLI 2221 - British Literature From 1800 Through The Present (3)
- ENGLI 2224 - American Literature From the Civil War to the Present (3)
- ENGLI 2226 - World Literature (3)

REQUIRED A.A. DEGREE PROGRAM TOTAL: 61 Hours
