Associate of Applied Science in Nursing to Bachelor of Science in Nursing

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Lewis and Clark Community College (L&C) and Governors State University (GovState) for the Nursing program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree from Nursing from L&C and a Bachelor of Science (BSN) degree in Nursing from GovState. Students are required to have a 2.0 G.P.A. for admission to the program. The BSN degree is offered at GovState completely online.
