

Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology - Sociology

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GovState) for the Anthropology-Sociology degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Arts (AA) degree from KCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Anthropology-Sociology at GovState.

I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION CORE CURRICULUM (39 Hours)

Communications (9 hours)

- ENGL 1613 - English I (3)
- ENGL 1623 - English II (3)

Humanities and Fine Arts (9 hours)

- Humanities, Fine Arts or Interdisciplinary course (3)*

Mathematics (4 hours)

Select one of the following:

- MATH 1774 - Statistics (4) (Meets MATH-2100 required by GovState)

Physical and Life Sciences (8 hours)

Select one life science course and one physical science course. One course must have a lab.

- Physical Science Course (4)*

Social and Behavioral Sciences (9 hours)

- PLSC 1513 - American Government (3) (recommended by KCC and GovState)
- PSYC 1813 - Introduction to Psychology (3) (required by KCC and GovState)
- SOCY 2513 - Sociology (3) (required by KCC and GovState)

II. AREA OF CONCENTRATION/MAJOR FIELD (9 Hours)

- ANTH 1713 - Introduction to Anthropology (3) (recommended)
- SOCY 2513 - Sociology (3) (Meets SOC 1100)
- SOCY 2543 - Race and Ethnic Relations (3) (rec; meet SOC 2200 as GovState Selective)

Selectives (18-21 Hours)

Students should select a minimum of 18 hours of upper-division courses from the approved list of selectives. A lower-division ANSO/ANTH/SOC course can count as a selective with advisor and program coordinator approval. Please meet with your program advisor for anticipated course offerings.
