



## Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology and Sociology

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Moraine Valley Community College (MVCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Anthropology and Sociology degree program based on the catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from MVCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Anthropology and Sociology from GSU.

### I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION CORE CURRICULUM: (39 Hours) Communications (9 hours)

- COM 101 - Composition I (3)

### Humanities and Fine Arts (9 hours)

### Mathematics (4 hours)

- MTH 139 - Probability and Statistics (4) (Meets MATH 2100) **OR**
- MTH 212 - Business Statistics (4) (Meets MATH 2100)

### Physical and Life Sciences (8 hours)

Select one life science course and one physical science course. One course must have a lab.

- Life Science Course (4)\*
- Physical Science Course (4)\*

### Social and Behavioral Sciences (9 hours)

- ANT 202 - Introduction to Cultural Anthropology (3) (Meets ANTH 1100)
- SOC 101 - General Sociology (3) (Meets SOC 1100)
- SOC 215 - Sociology of Sex and Gender (3) (recommended; meet ANSO 2100 as GSU Selective)

### II. ADDITIONAL MVCC DEGREE REQUIREMENT (3 Hours)

Select three credit hours from Humanities and Fine Arts or Social/Behavioral Sciences listed above or one of the following ARB 101, 102, or 201; FRE 101,102, or 201; or SPA 101, 102, or 201.

### III. ELECTIVES (20 Hours)

GSU's Anthropology and Sociology program suggests classes in any of the social sciences.

- SOC 210 - Minority Groups (3) (recommended)
- Free Electives (17)\*
