



Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in English with Teacher Education

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Moraine Valley Community College (MVCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the English – Teacher Education degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from MVCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in English from GSU. **The BA in English – Teacher Education program has special admissions requirements; please refer to the GSU catalog.**
