



Associate in Arts to Bachelor in Arts in Psychology

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Moraine Valley Community College (MVCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Psychology degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from MVCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Psychology from GSU.

- PSY 101 - Introduction to Psychology (3) (Meets PSYC 1101)

- Social and Behavioral Science Course – Non-Psychology Course (3)*

II. ADDITIONAL MVCC DEGREE REQUIREMENT (3 Hours)

Select three credit hours from Humanities and Fine Arts or Social/Behavioral Sciences listed above or one of the following ARB 101, 102, or 201; FRE 101,102, or 201; or SPA 101, 102, or 201.

Psychology Electives (6-12 Hours)

A minimum of 6-12 credits must be at the 3000-4000 level.

A minimum of 4-22 hours must be at the 3000-4000 level. (Amounts will vary based on concentration if selected and psychology electives completed.)
