Call to Order

The meeting was called to order to provide updates on partner initiatives, review upcoming events, and continue planning for recovery-focused community engagement efforts in Clark County.

Welcome and Introductions

Council members introduced themselves and shared organizational roles.

Agency Updates

- Gateway Foundation is offering a free continuing education event in June and is now offering primary mental health services via Telehealth.

- HRC is beginning the 15 week Invitation to Change group. More information on dates and times will be emailed out.
- Birth Through 5 is actively recruiting family council members and a recruitment flyer will be shared.

Laundry Day's

- Quarterly free laundry dates will be scheduled and shared with the council.
- Sponsorship needs and cost management remain priorities. The current average cost is \$200-\$250 per event.

Recovery Month Planning

- Recovery Picnic and Recovery Lives Here event is set for Oct 3rd, 2026.
- Clark County ROSC Coordinator will look into venues including, Harlan Hall, the Clark County Fair Grounds, and the park.
- Jessica Parrill suggested inviting first responders to attend and participate.
- Promotional materials for the Recovery Lives Here campaign are almost complete and ready to distribute.
- Outreach will need to be done to recruit businesses to participate and to find local people willing to share their stories.
- Local sober living facilities and resources will be offered an information table.

Annual Candlelight Vigil

- Council will be seeking speakers which may include a PLE, Support person, and/or pastor.

Other Outreach Activities

- The council is hoping to partner with Sheriff Bill Brown and D.A.R.E at the Marshall Night Out event in early August to provide a HIPS for parents. More details once available.
- The Clark County ROSC Council will have an information table at the Together for Veterans vendor expo at Harlan Hall on Sept 24th from 10-3.

- We will be creating a float/display for the Autumn Fest Parade in Sept. More details once available.

Free Mini Golf & Narcan Training

- Event is scheduled for June 20th. The council opted to provide drinks and snacks if allowed. A sign up sheet to donate will be sent out.

Recovery Court Panel Recap

- The event had attendance of around 50 people and was well received. Local TV stations did a story on the topic and event. Subcommittee meeting dates will be sent out soon.

Priority Projects and Strategic Plan

- The coordinator reviewed a consolidated list of priority projects, marked completed objectives separately, and noted work toward FY27 goals. A final Q4 report is due in July and an impact report draft is being prepared for partners and social media; council input was requested.
