Narcan ONEBoxes	Narcan ONEBoxes have been purchased with grant funds. Rhonda has a total of 40 boxes with 20 of those having an informational video and 20 without the video. ComWell has provided the initial box of Narcan for the ONEboxes through the Drug Overdose Prevention Program (DOPP). Businesses are encouraged to register with DOPP so they can obtain free Narcan in the future. Rhonda W gave a “heads up” that businesses who received Narcan from us previously may have Narcan that is expired. If so, we can replace.
